Welcome to Year 6 and Wolves class- we work together and support each other as a pack.

**Curriculum:** We will be looking at all our subjects through the concept of 'Perspective' by developing our understanding of what we believe and how our perspective of the world is shaped. Our first class novel is 'Wonder' by R J Palacio.

**PE:** Our PE lessons are on Thursday and Fridays. Please ensure your child has the correct labelled clothing in school on these days.

**Homework:** The focus for homework at the moment is Reading. The children have a text to practise reading at home to develop their fluency (the ease and flow of their reading) and I will hear them read this each week and give them a harder one when they are ready. They also have a reading book they need to read regularly. Spellings are set in a separate book with space for the children to practise their words daily. This book must be in school every Monday for new personalised spellings to be set which will be tested on the following Monday.
